



Air Wing

- Objective: create interest amongst the youth of the nation in aviation activities.
- In the Flying Sqns, besides normal trg, cdts are imparted trg in gliding / microlite flying activities.
- COs and GIs of Air Sqns under them, attain glider and microlite instructor status within two months of their posting to the Sqn.
- Microlite, gliders and winches are kept in a high state of serviceability.

Army Wing

- Objectives:
 - to achieve a good proficiency in weapon training, Firing, Map Reading, Field Engineering, Communication, Health and Hygiene as also understand the broad outline org of Army Units.

Naval Wing

- **Targets**

- Train of minimum four cdts in windsurfing per windsurfer.



Incentives: NCC cadets by centre and state Govts

S.N.	Type	Incentive
1	Vacancies reserved for Army 64 per year	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Indian Military commission in Defence Forces Academy (IMA), Dehradun through for NCC 'C' Certificate UPSC and Service Selection Board (SSB) Interview.2. 100 per year - in Officers Training Academy (OTA), Chennai for Short Service Commission3. Non Technical No UPSC Exam, only SSB.4. Navy -6 per Course. No UPSC exam, Only Naval SSB5. IAF – 10 % in all courses including Flying Training courses. No UPSC Exam only Air Force SSB.
2.	For ORs, Sailors, Airmen	5 to 10% bonus marks awarded for recruitment.
3.	Para Military Forces	2 to 10 bonus marks awarded for recruitment
4.	Department of Telecommunication	Bonus marks awarded for recruitment.

S.N.	Type	Incentive
5.	CRPF	NCC Cadets holding third division degree eligible for recruitment to gazetted post
6.	National Cadet Corps	Civilian Gliding Instructors/Girl Cadet Instructors and NCC WTLOs
7.	State Governments	Preference in State Services in certain states.
8.	Industry	Some Industries give preference to NCC 'C' certificate holders for various jobs e.g. Reliance Industries Security Officers are selected from NCC C certificate holders.
9.	Concessions by Haryana,	Preference for recruitment in Home Guard Deptt and State Police Force. Preference for recruitment to State Police Force
10.	Concessions by HP	Weight age for admission to various courses of study in Himachal Pradesh University
11.	Concessions by Punjab Govt	Weightage of marks given for admission in various courses in State Govt Polytechnics, Colleges and Universities.

Grading awarded in NCC Exams

S.No.	Grade	Criteria
1.	Pass marks	45% marks in each paper and 50% marks in aggregate
2.	A	80% marks or above
3.	B	65% marks and above but below 80%
4.	C	50% marks and above but below 65%
5.	Fail	Less than 45% in any paper or less than 50% of the aggregate
