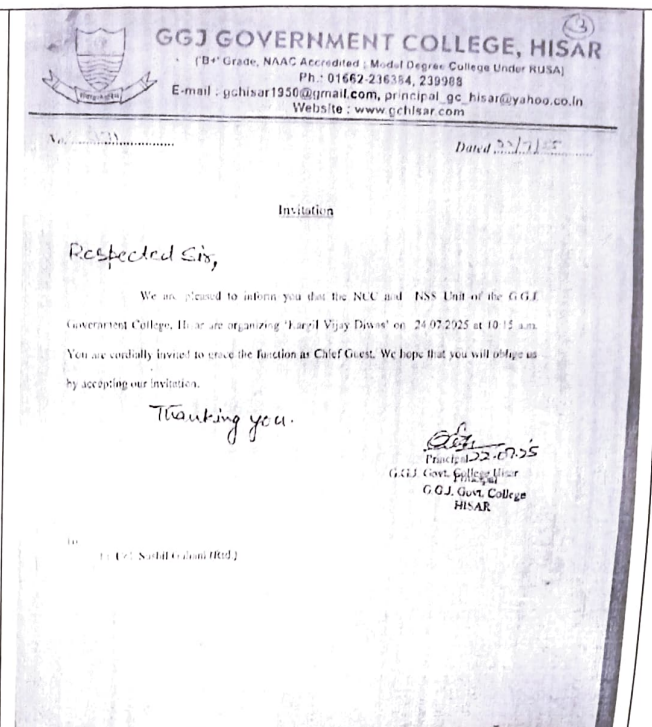
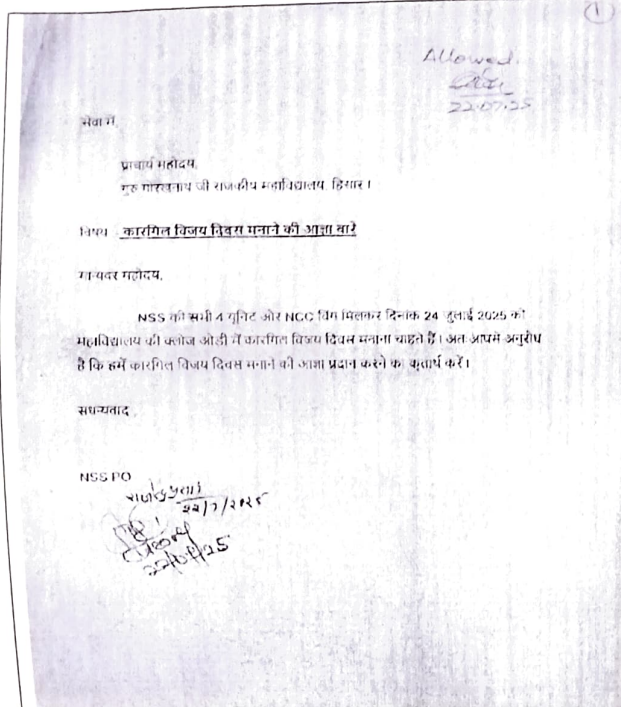

The central theme of the posters and slogans was to spread awareness among students and society about the ill effects of drugs.

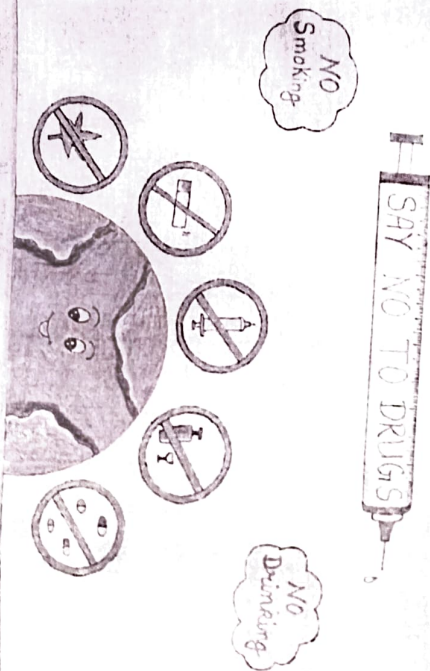
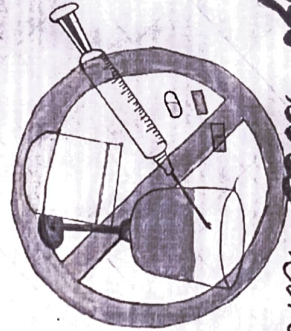
While addressing the students, Principal Dr. Vivek Kumar Saini motivated them to stay away from drugs and contribute towards building a prosperous society.

Action Taken Report

Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan (NMBA)

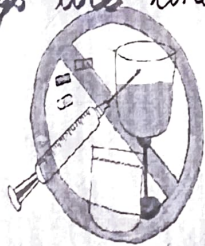

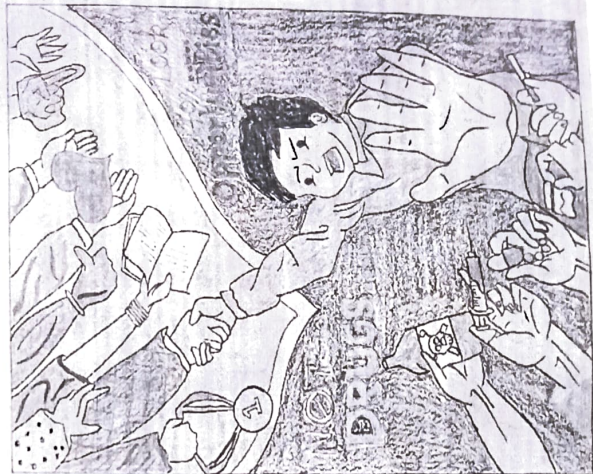

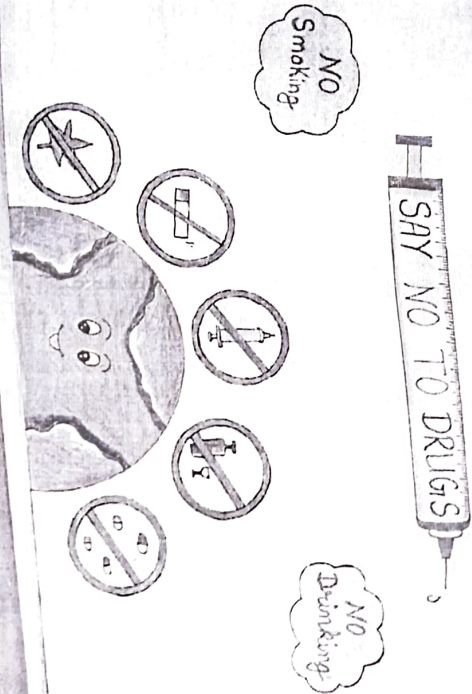

NSS Orientation Programme

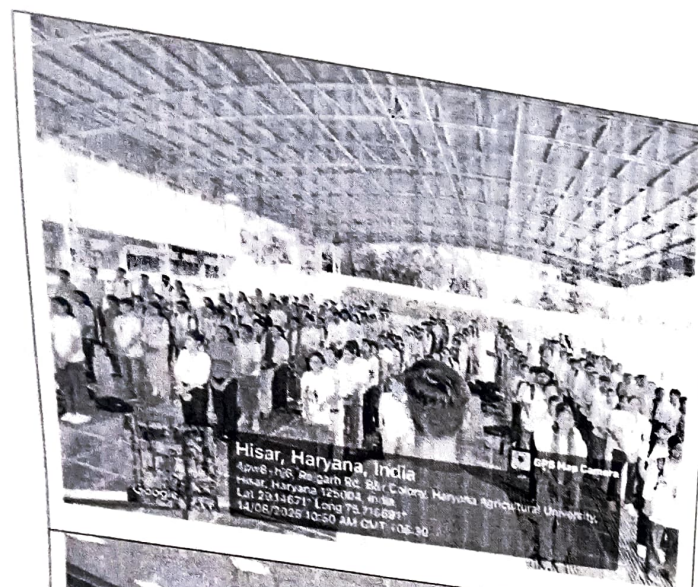
